SOLICITOR & CANVASSING REGISTRATION FORM FOR INDIVIDUALS

Watertown City Ordinance - Chapter XIX

Except as may be expressly provided herein, it shall be unlawful for any person or organization to engage in soliciting or canvassing, as those activities are defined in Section 3 of this ordinance, within the limits of the Town of Watertown without first registering with the Police Department in accordance with Section 4 of the ordinance. The registration requirement of this ordinance shall be in addition to any requirements for registration imposed by Massachusetts General Law C.101, §34.
