There is no charge to a resident if the animal is homeless or if it is wildlife. Call ARL for an ambulance or transport an animal to ARL. ARL will accept any sick or injured wildlife.

The wildlife clinic <u>will not accept</u> bats, skunks, raccoons, groundhogs, or deer. If an animal appears healthy (i.e. baby bird out of it's nest) Tufts will suggest disregarding the animal or contacting a local rehabilitator. During the busy season (summer) there is a limit to the number of raccoons they can accept. There is no charge to the citizen for surrender, the clinic is based on donations.
